

*We received the request of student party SAM to facilitate studying on campus prior to examination periods. We share your view that we as a university have a responsibility to help students in the best way we can and understand that the campus can be a place to focus in these rather stressful times.*

*As already explained in the DB-meeting we wanted to take the new Corona-measures into account when making a decision about your request. Also, over the past period supporting staff has been working overtime and it takes time to arrange everything regarding staff schedules, cleaning, security and supervision. Therefore we were unable to realize the request before the exams of October. However, we will open self-study workplaces in the weekend starting November 7th. Provided of course, that the national or regional Corona measures allow this and are not further tightened. As usual, the workplaces will not be available on Christmas Day, Boxing Day and New Year's Day.*

*In your memo you stated that studying on campus can be crucial for students to be able to concentrate on their work. We acknowledge this. Therefore we have increased the capacity of self-study workplaces, as already indicated in the University Council. We appreciate your efforts in the interest of students and invite you to keep contributing ideas on how to deal with the corona crisis.*
